About Sandy Springs

The City of Sandy Springs is Georgia's sixth largest city and the second largest city in the Metro Atlanta area. The City is located just north of the metropolis of Atlanta. Sandy Springs occupies a land area of 37 square miles and serves a population of 99,000.

Some Facts and Figures

The City of Sandy Springs was incorporated on December 1, 2005.

The Sandy Springs Police Department was launched on July 1, 2006 with 86 police officers with an average of 10 years of service. Today the SSPD has 128 Sworn Officers.

The boundaries of Sandy Springs are Atlanta to the south, Cobb County at the Chattahoochee River to the west, Roswell to the north, and Dunwoody to the east.

12 Miles of Interstate 285 and 19 Miles of Georgia 400 are within the city limits of Sandy Springs.

Sandy Springs is home to three major hospitals: Northside Hospital, St. Josephs Hospital, and Children's Healthcare of Atlanta.

The City of Sandy Springs is served by 7 public elementary schools, 2 public middle schools, 2 public high schools and 8 private schools.

Sandy Springs has been ranked ninth most affluent out of 420 U.S. communities with populations over 75,000. Only 1 other city placed ahead of Sandy Springs in the south. The seven others are in California.

Sandy Springs has a median household income of \$71,592 and median house value of \$486,500.
