



Whistle Defense Program

Sandy Springs Police

Any adult resident of Sandy Springs may pick up their free American Whistle at the front desk of the SSPD. Each whistle includes instructions about the program and a lanyard.

If you are accosted on the street:

- Blow the whistle.
- Call the police as soon as possible.

If you fear trouble on the street:

- Blow your whistle.
- Call the police

If you see trouble on the street:

- Blow your whistle.
- Keep a safe distance.
- Call the police.

If you see trouble from your home:

- Call the police.
- Open a window and blow the whistle.

If you hear a whistle:

- Call the police.

Do NOT play police officer:

- Don't get hurt.
- We are trained to handle problems.
- Alerting the SSPD is your role in community policing.

Tell kids about your whistle:

- From a child's perspective, a whistle is a great toy. And while there are toy whistles, your American Defender is not one of them. They are safety tools and should be respected as such.
